Web Services

The SirsiDynix Web Services Workshop is a 4-hour group Hands-On Lab course providing System Administrators access to the most recent SirsiDynix Symphony or Horizon Web Services. Topics covered will include:

- Differences between our legacy Web Services and the new ROA Web Services
- How to interpret requests and responses from various Web Services.

Enterprise Development Advanced (BC927)
